BRISTOL MOUNTAIN BEGINS SNOWMAKING OPERATIONS FOR 2008-09 WINTER SEASON

Canandaigua, NY (November 17, 2008) – Bristol Mountain Winter Resort, known throughout the region for its 1,200' vertical rise (the highest of any resort between the Adirondack Mountains and the Rocky Mountains) began snowmaking operations for the 2008-09 winter season at 9 p.m. on Monday, November 17th.

Bristol's Mountain Manager, Ken Keenan said, "Conditions were conducive for operations to begin on the Upper and Lower Rocket, Upper and Lower Meteor, Upper Galaxy, Comet and Sunbelt trails."

Bristol Mountain General Manager, Dan Fuller noted, "Snowmaking operations will continue to expand throughout the area as the temperatures and conditions allow."

When patrons return for the 2008-09 winter season some of the improvements they can expect to see will include, a 400' Magic Carpet Brand Surface Type Conveyor lift, a new summit Ski Patrol headquarters and a new mid-mountain café, named the Morning Star Café which is located on the lower end of the Morning Star Trail.
